**Team event will consist of 3 nominated riders competing in the following classes:

- Primary Teams - from classes 1, 2 or 3.
- Post primary Teams – from classes 4, 5, 6 or 7.
- Teams must be nominated before the event (ie. when making entries)
- All scores count towards the team event.
- Schools may join together to form a mixed team.

General Info:

- All entries must be made via the Gransha App on or before **Monday 16th March**. No late entries will be accepted after this date! All entries are £15 per class.
- The same horse/rider combination can only compete in two classes.
- Times will be available on the Gransha app on Thursday 19th March.
- All dressage tests can be called. Spurs only permitted if riders are wearing the appropriate pony club spurs hat tag.
- Only bridles and bits permitted under **British Dressage rules** are allowed.
- Tack inspections on the day. A special award will be presented to the best turned out in each class. School sports tops or show jackets are permitted.
